

- Open access is a form of scientific publishing. The idea comes from science itself.
- Open access means free access to scientific publications and information in digital form.
- Funding and scientific organizations are committed to the goal of making research results freely accessible to everyone worldwide free of charge and without technical or legal barriers.
- At the University of Bonn, open access is a strategic goal.

Payment of fees for open-access books (monographs or edited volumes)



bonndoc is the publication server of the University of Bonn – a place to publish and archive documents. With bonndoc, the university offers its members an infrastructure for publishing open access publications.

This service is free of costs for you.

YOUR PUBLICATION IN BONNDOC ...







- can be browsed easily in the **full text** and is thus found more quickly.
- is accessible **worldwide** and **free of charge**.
- is **retrievable** via search engines and is thus **more visible**.
- can be found internationally and nationally via **library systems**.
- can be **cited** online by providing permanent URLs.
- is **archived long-term** via the USL Bonn and the German National Library.













Check the <u>copyright</u> of your publication. You need to have the proper rights.



Convert your file into a PDF (ideally PDF/A). This will make it easier for us to digitally archive your publication.



Log in with your Uni-ID and submit your publication <u>online</u>. Please note the accepted <u>types of publication</u> and the submission workflow.



OPEN JOURNAL SYSTEMS







Open Journal Systems (OJS) is a system for managing and publishing digital journals. It provides support for all the steps involved in creating a journal (submission, peer review, reviewers' feedback, etc.). With OJS you can also start a new journal.

This service is free of charge.

OPEN JOURNAL SYSTEMS









- easy publication and comfortable administration and editing
- open and **non-commercial** platform for open access publications
- publication process and platform in the hands of the scientific community
- mostly no fees for articles contributed by authors
- Server and hosting of OJS journals free of charge for members of the University of Bonn
